Attendance Matters at Cootamundra High!



Data strongly supports the understanding that students will **achieve their educational best** and **increase their career and life options** through **regular attendance** at school.

- In NSW, **all children** from the age of 6 are legally required to attend school or be registered for <u>home schooling</u>.
- All students must complete Year 10, or its equivalent. Young people below the age
 of 17 must be:
 - o in school, or registered for home schooling
 - in approved education or training, such as a traineeship, apprenticeship or TAFE
 - o in full-time paid employment (average 25 hours a week)
 - o in a combination of work, education and/or training.
- Students 17 years and over who are enrolled in school are required to attend school regularly to meet HSC course requirements.
- Parents must explain all absences to the school within 7 days.

At Cootamundra High School parents of absent students are **automatically sent a text message** informing them that an absence has been recorded.

We request that parents **explain the absence** to the school as soon as possible, within 7 days, by phone, written note, in person, or via the Sentral Parent Portal or Skoolbag app.
