## School Sport Policy

Cootamundra High School supports and promotes safe and engaging participation in school sport for all students. There are rules and regulations around the participation in school sport, which include Wednesday school sport and Cootamundra High School representative sport. All stake holders have been consulted and support this policy.

### At Cootamundra High School students are expected to:

- Respect other students, their teachers and school staff and community members
- Respect and follow school rules
- Consistently wear Cootamundra High School uniform with pride (NB: Representative apparel is NOT considered part of the Cootamundra High School uniform)
- Display behaviours, attitudes and actions that are consistently positive
- Ensure all N Determination work is satisfactorily completed
- Maintain regular attendance greater than 90%
- Complete and hand in sport choices forms
- Provide a medical certificate if they are unable to participate in school sport

### At Cootamundra High School teachers are expected to:

- Plan and implement safe, engaging sport for all students
- Mark rolls accurately on Sentral
- Manage behavioural issues, following the regular classroom management process
- Communicate any issues regarding venues or equipment to the sports coordinator
- Be familiar with the NSW DET requirements for all sport and physical activity found at <https://app.education.nsw.gov.au/sport/File/1449>

### At Cootamundra High School the Sports Coordinator is expected to:

- Create and manage sports groups, ensuring all rolls are accurate
- Supply a range of sporting options for students to participate in during Wednesday school sport
- Communicate all relevant information regarding venues, cost, equipment and transport to all stakeholders including parents, students and other teaching staff
- Create and distribute weekly staff roster
- Organise and ensure all venues and equipment are safe and ready for use

**NB: Students returning from a suspension will not be eligible to represent Cootamundra High School in any sport for a period of 5 weeks from day of return to timetabled classes.**

Students who have represented Cootamundra High School at a regional, state or national level can have this acknowledgement embroidered onto their school jumper or shirt at the expense of the school.
